

URGENT SAFETY ALERT
CERTAIN 2007 and 2008 GAS-POWERED
ALL WHEEL DRIVE UTILITY VEHICLES
Club Car Carryall 295, Carryall 295SE, XRT1550, XRT1550SE,
Bobcat 2200, 2200S
Husqvarna HUV 4421, HUV4421XP

Dear Club Car Customer:

Club Car, Inc., in cooperation with the U. S. Consumer Product Safety Commission, is notifying select owners and operators of 2007 and 2008 model year all-wheel drive utility vehicles of possible lack of carburetor grounding in certain units manufactured with a Kawasaki gas-powered engine. This problem, if not corrected, could present a potential risk of sparking; thus, Club Car is undertaking a voluntary installation of a grounding strap with certain 2007 and 2008 model year vehicles.

In an abundance of caution, Club Car, in conjunction with its dealers and distributors, has initiated a field campaign to install a grounding strap in the vehicles manufactured with a Kawasaki gas-powered engine. The installation will be done free of charge.

This letter provides the information you will need to identify the affected vehicles and the actions required to ensure that carburetor grounding in your vehicle's engine is corrected expeditiously.

Which vehicles are affected?

- Certain 2007 and 2008 Club Car, Bobcat and Husqvarna all-wheel drive utility manufactured with a Kawasaki gas-powered engine. A full listing of affected models and serial numbers is attached. Diesel-powered vehicles and golf car models **are not** affected.

What is the problem?

- Certain Kawasaki gas-powered engines may not have adequate grounding for the carburetor.

Immediate actions for affected vehicles:

- Our records indicate that you are the current owner of a 2007 or 2008 gas-powered all-wheel drive or rough terrain vehicle manufactured with the affected engine.

STEP 1:

- Determine whether the serial number(s) of your all-wheel drive or rough terrain vehicle is on the list of potentially affected vehicles in Table 1. The serial number is located on a decal just above and to the right of the accelerator pedal. The serial number consists of a two-letter prefix followed by a ten-digit number. The prefix and number must both match the model listings shown below for your vehicle to be affected.

- If you own a vehicle with a serial number that matches the lists in table 1 with a Kawasaki gas-powered engine, immediately contact your authorized Club Car dealer or call Club Car at **1-800-227-0739, ext. 3580** between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. ET to arrange for installation of a grounding strap.
- If you own a 2007 or 2008 all-wheel drive or rough terrain vehicle with a Kawasaki engine, and a serial number listed above, **DO NOT USE IT UNTIL THE GROUNDING STRAP IS INSTALLED.**
